

Assemble Your Device

This section helps you to assemble your device.

Wireless Charger



Devices and software are constantly evolving - the illustrations you see here are for reference only.

Charge the Battery

Your device is powered by a rechargeable Li-Ion battery.

Warning: Do not disassemble, modify, or repair your device. Placing objects, such as magnetic stripe cards, including credit cards, phone cards, passbooks, and boarding passes, next to the device or charger may cause damage from the charger or device's magnetic field.

The battery comes partially charged. You can use the device while charging.

- 1. Insert the USB cable into the USB charger port.
- Connect the USB cable to the charging head, and then plug the charging head into a standard outlet.
- 3. Place the Gear onto the wireless charger dock.



Caution: Use only charging devices that are approved by Samsung. Samsung accessories are designed for your device to maximize battery life. Using other accessories may void your warranty and may cause damage. While charging, the device and the charger may become hot. This does not affect the device's lifespan or performance and is in the device's normal range of operation.

The charger may stop charging if the battery becomes too hot.

If the device heats up while charging the battery:

- 1. Disconnect the charger from the device and close any running apps.
- 2. Wait for the device to cool down and then begin charging the device again.

Note: Prevent the USB charger port and the small end of the charger from coming into contact with conductive materials, such as liquids, dust, metal powders, and pencil leads.

Check the Charge Status

When you connect the Gear and the wireless charger dock, the wireless charger dock's LED indicator flashes certain colors to indicate the battery level.


- Red > Green > Orange: Standby mode
- Red: Charging.
- Green: Fully charged
- **Orange**: Connected to a low-charger head

Note: When a wireless charger dock error occurs, the LED indicator flashes red. Disconnect the Gear from the wireless charger dock, and then reconnect. If the error occurs again, contact a Samsung Service Center for service support.

Wear the Gear

Wear the Gear firmly around your lower arm just above your wrist as shown below. Do not fasten the Gear too tightly.

- 1. Open the buckle and place the strap around your wrist.
- 2. Fit the strap to your wrist, insert the pin into an adjustment hole, and then secure the buckle to close it.



Warning: If you feel discomfort while using the device, stop using it. If your device becomes hot, please remove it until it cools.

Strap Tips and Precautions


- Some people may experience discomfort when wearing the Gear for prolonged periods.
- If you have sensitive skin or fasten the Gear too tightly, you may feel some discomfort.
- Do not expose the straps to very wet conditions. Wet straps can cause skin irritations. Dry the straps first. If you experience skin irritation when wearing the device, stop wearing the device and consult a physician.

Replace the Strap

Detach the strap from the Gear to replace it with a new one.


To remove the strap:

 Slide the strap's spring bar inwards and pull the strap away from the Gear.



To replace the strap:

 Insert one end of the spring bar into the lug, slide the spring bar inwards, and connect the new strap.



Set Up Your Device

Start Using Your Device

Turn Your Device On or Off

The instructions below explain how to turn your device on or off.

To turn the device on:

 Press and hold the **Power** button until the device turns on.

To turn the device off:

- 1. Press and hold the **Power** button.
- 2. Tap Power off.

Lock or Unlock Your Device

Use your device's screen lock features to secure your device.

Your Gear locks when you remove it from your wrist or when the screen times out while you are wearing it.

The default Screen lock on your device is None. To choose a more secure screen lock, see <u>"Set a Screen Lock" on page 91</u>.

To unlock the device:

▶ Press the **Power** button or **Back** button.

Use the Set Up Wizard

When you turn on the Gear for the first time or reset it, the Setup wizard is displayed. Follow the prompts to learn about your device's features.

Samsung Gear App

To connect your Gear to a smartphone, install the Samsung Gear app on the smartphone. You can download the Samsung Gear app from Galaxy Apps, or Google Play[™] store.

Compatible with select devices using Android 4.4 and later, with at least 1.5 GB RAM. Supported devices may vary by carrier and device. Some features may not be available. For best results, connect with compatible Samsung Galaxy devices. For a list of compatible smartphones, please visit samsung.com/us/support/owners/product/gear-sport.

Connect the Gear to a Smartphone

- 1. Turn on the Gear.
- 2. From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap Samsung Gear.
 - If necessary, update the Samsung Gear app to the latest version.
- 3. Tap **Start the Journey**, and follow the prompts to select your device.
- When the Bluetooth[®] pairing request window is displayed, confirm the passkeys displayed on your Gear and smartphone match, and then tap OK.
- 5. Follow the prompts to complete the connection.

When the devices are connected, a tutorial is displayed on the Gear's screen. Follow the prompts to learn basic controls.

Connect the Gear to a New Smartphone

When you connect the Gear to another smartphone, the Gear automatically resets and all data is removed from its memory. Make sure you back up any important data stored on your Gear.

- 1. Back up your Gear's data on your smartphone as follows:
 - From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > About Gear > Back up and restore > Back up settings.
- 2. End the connection between your Gear and smartphone.
- 3. Connect your Gear to another smartphone.

Remote Connection

Set the Gear to remotely connect to the smartphone when a Bluetooth connection between the devices is not available. With this connection, you can still receive notifications from your smartphone.

To enable or disable this feature:

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap Samsung Gear > Settings tab.
- 2. Tap Gear connection > Remote connection.

Note: You must connect the Gear to Wi-Fi and sign in to your Samsung account on the smartphone to enable this feature.

Auto Switch Device

If you have connected two or more wearable devices to your smartphone, they are remembered in the Samsung Gear app. If a connected wearable device is disconnected, the Samsung Gear app searches for another remembered wearable device and connects to it.

- 1. From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap Samsung Gear.
- Tap More options > Auto switch device, and tap On/Off to enable the feature.


Disconnect

- 1. From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap Samsung Gear.
- Tap More options > Disconnect, and then confirm when prompted. The Gear disconnects from your smartphone.

Learn About Your Device

Learn some of the key features of your device, including the screens and icons, as well as how to navigate the device.


Front View



Devices and software are constantly evolving — the illustrations you see here are for reference only.

- Bezel
 - Rotate the bezel to navigate through screens and to select options.
- Back button
 - Press to return to the previous screen.
 - Press to pause a workout while tracking your exercise.
- Power/Home button
 - Press and hold to turn the Gear on or off.
 - Press to turn on the screen.
 - Press and hold for more than seven seconds to restart the Gear.
 - Press to open the Apps screen when you are on the Watch screen.
 - Press to open the Watch screen when you are on any other screen.

Back View

Navigation

Learn the basics for how to navigate through your device.

Touchscreen Navigation

Please note that a touch screen responds best to a light touch from the pad of your finger or a capacitive stylus. Using excessive force or a metallic object when pressing on the touch screen may damage the tempered glass surface and void the warranty.

Lightly tap items to select or launch them.

- Tap an app to open it or a menu item to select it.
- Tap to press an on-screen button.

Swipe

Lightly drag your finger vertically or horizontally across the screen.

• Swipe to the left or right to view other panels.

Touch and Hold

Touch and hold items on the screen to activate them.

- Touch and hold a widget on a Home screen to move it.
- Touch and hold the screen for two or more seconds to access the Edit mode or to view available options.

Drag

Touch and hold an item, and then move it to a new location.

• Drag an app shortcut to place it in a new location on an Apps screen.

Watch Screen

The Watch screen is the starting point for the Gear. Rotate the bezel left or right to view notifications and widgets.



Customize Your Watch Screens

Change the Watch Face

- Touch and hold the Watch screen, and then rotate the bezel to view available watch faces.
 - You can add more watch faces by rotating the bezel to the last screen and tapping **Galaxy Apps**.
- 2. Tap the watch face to select it.
 - You can customize the watch face by tapping **Customize**.

You can also change the Gear's watch face on your smartphone:

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Watch faces.
- 2. Tap a desired watch face. The watch face you selected is applied on the Watch screen.
- 3. Tap **Customize** to select a background and items to display on the watch face.

Suggested Watch Faces

View recommended watch faces available to download.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Info tab.
- 2. Tap View more watch faces to see options.

Widgets

You can add widgets to the Home screens. Widgets are small apps that offer limited functionality to provide information and convenient access.

Add Widgets

To add more widgets on the Home screen:

- Rotate the bezel to the end of the Widget screens, and tap + Add widget.
- 2. Select a widget.
 - The selected widget is displayed in a new panel.


Move Widgets

 Touch and hold a widget and then drag it to the desired location.

Remove Widgets

► Touch and hold a widget, and then tap — Delete.

Power Saving

Activate power saving mode to save battery power by limiting the Gear's functions.

- I. On the Watch screen, swipe down from the top of the screen to open the status panel.
- 2. Tap Dower saving, and then tap VOn.

Airplane Mode

Airplane mode disconnects your device from all networks and turns off connectivity features, such as Bluetooth and Wi-Fi.

- 1. On the Watch screen, swipe down from the top of the screen to open the status panel.
- 2. Tap 🛧 Airplane mode, and then tap 🗸 On.

Water Lock Mode

You can use Water lock mode to exercise in the water. The touchscreen, the wake-up gesture feature, and watch always on feature will turn off.

To enable Water lock mode:

- 1. On the Watch screen, swipe down from the top of the screen to open the status panel.
- Tap Water lock mode, and then tap VOn.
- Press and hold the Home button to turn off the mode.

Do Not Disturb Mode

You can set the Gear not to vibrate and turn off the screen when a notification, except for alarms, is received.

- 1. On the Watch screen, swipe down from the top of the screen to open the status panel.
- 2. Tap **Do not disturb**, and select a length of time.
- 3. Tap 🗸 **On**.

Watch Always On

Set the Gear to display a watch when the screen is turned off.

- 1. On the Watch screen, swipe down from the top of the screen to open the status panel.
- 2. Tap 🕒 Watch always on, and then tap 🗸 On.

Adjust the Brightness

You can adjust the Gear's display brightness to suit the environment.

- 1. On the Watch screen, swipe down from the top of the screen to open the status panel.
- Tap Drightness and adjust the level by rotating the bezel.

Play Music

You can play music saved on the Gear or smartphone. For more information, see <u>"Music Player" on page 48</u>.

- 1. On the Watch screen, swipe down from the top of the screen to open the status panel.
- 2. Tap > Music to open the Music Player app.

Customize Quick Settings

Manage the Quick settings that appear on the Status panel.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- 2. Tap Device > Edit quick settings.
 - Tap **Remove** to remove a quick setting.
 - Tap 🕂 Add to select a new quick setting.
 - Touch and hold, and then drag a quick setting to change its order.

Notifications

Stay up to date with events, notifications, and messages from your smartphone.

When you receive a notification, information about the notification, such as its type, is displayed on the screen while the Gear is vibrating.

- 1. Rotate the bezel left.
- 2. Tap the notification screen to view details.

View the Notifications List

To view a list of notifications from the same app:

- 1. From the Watch screen, rotate the bezel left to view notifications.
- 2. Tap the number at the bottom of the notification.

Clear All Notifications

To clear all notifications:

- 1. From the Watch screen, rotate the bezel left to view notifications.
- 2. Rotate the bezel to the end of the notifications screens, and then tap ill Clear all.

Block Notifications

To block notifications from an app:

- 1. From the Watch screen, rotate the bezel left to view notifications.
- 2. Tap a notification from the app that you want to block.
- 3. Tap the notification to view the details.
- 4. Tap More options > Block app.

Notification Settings

Change settings for the notification feature.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Notifications.
- 2. Tap **On/Off** to activate it, and then tap to select items:
 - Manage notifications: Select apps on the smartphone to send notifications to the Gear.
 - Show only while wearing Gear: Show notifications on your Gear only while it is being worn.
 - Show while using phone: Show notifications from your phone on your Gear while you are using your phone.
 - **Turn on screen**: Set the Gear to turn on the screen when the notification is received.

- Auto show details: Set the Gear to show details for notifications when they are received.
- Notification indicator: Show a yellow indicator on the watch face when there are unread notifications.
- **Smart relay**: Set the smartphone to display notification information from the Gear when you pick up the smartphone.

Enter Text

Text can be entered by speaking or by using a keyboard.

A text input screen is displayed automatically when you are able to enter text. Select an emoticon or text template to enter a message. You can also use voice input or the keyboard to type texts.



Default keyboard

Select a default keyboard type for text input.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- Tap General management > Input > Default keyboard and select your default keyboard.

Note: This option is only available if you have downloaded additional keyboards from Galaxy Apps.

Voice Input

To use Voice input:


- ► Tap Voice input and speak the message you want to enter. Tap Send when you are finished.
 - Tap More options > Input languages to change the language. Voice input is not supported in some languages.



Emojis

You can add emojis to your message.

- Tap () Emojis, and select an emoji to include in your message.
 - To draw an image, tap **Doodle**.



Keyboard

Use the keyboard to enter your message. You can rotate the bezel to different input modes.

Handwriting Mode

 Tap B Keyboard, and then use your finger to write text.



Enter Characters

To enter characters:

- 1. Tap **E** Keyboard, and then rotate the bezel to character mode.
- 2. Tap the corresponding key repeatedly until the desired character is displayed.
 - Rotate the bezel for numbers, punctuation, emojis, or voice input.



Keyboard Settings

Change the Samsung keyboard settings.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- Tap General management > Input > Keyboard settings and tap options to customize:
 - English (US): Choose the keyboard layout.
 - Select input languages: Select languages for text input.
 - Check for updates: Set the Gear to check for and download the latest version of the Samsung keyboard.
 - Handwriting: Enable handwriting mode.
 - Smart typing:
 - Predictive text: Activate predictive text mode to predict English words based on your input and display word suggestions.

- Auto capitalize: Set the Gear to automatically capitalize the first character after a final punctuation mark, such as a period, question mark, or exclamation mark.
- Auto punctuate: Set the Gear to insert a period when you double-tap the space bar.
- Key-tap feedback:
 - Vibration: Set the Gear to vibrate when you tap a key.
- Reset keyboard settings: Reset the Samsung keyboard settings.
- Clear personalized data: Clear word predictions and other data.

Apps

Learn how to change the way apps are displayed and uninstall or disable apps.

Use Apps

The Apps list displays all preloaded and downloaded apps. You can uninstall, disable, or hide apps from view.

Access Apps

The Apps screen displays icons for all apps.

- 1. From the Watch screen, press the **Home** button to go to the Apps screen.
- To view other panels, rotate the bezel. You can also tap Next/Previous screen or swipe the screen to the left or right.

Open Apps

 On the Apps screen, tap an app icon to open the app.

Auto Open Apps

Set an app to launch by rotating the bezel without tapping the app. When the bezel indicator icon hovers over an app, the app will be launched automatically.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- 2. Tap App settings > Auto open apps.
- 3. Тар 🗸 **ОК**.

Recent Apps

To open an app from the list of recently used apps:

 From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap Recent apps.

Arrange Apps

Select how to arrange the apps on the Apps screen.

- 2. Tap App settings > App order, and select an option:
 - Most recent first: Recently used apps to appear first.
 - **Custom**: Arrange the apps to your preference.
 - From the Apps screen, touch and hold an app, and then drag it to the desired location.

From your Smartphone:

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Apps.
- 2. Tap More options > Reorder.
- Touch and hold \$\lapha\$ Move app next to an app, and then drag the app up or down to another position.

Install Apps

You can purchase and download apps specially designed for the Gear. To use this feature, your Gear and smartphone must be connected.

From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Galaxy Apps, and then tap a category.

To download apps for your Gear from your smartphone in the Samsung Gear app:

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Samsung Galaxy Apps.
- 2. Browse apps by category or search for apps by keyword, and then select an app to download.

Suggested Apps

View recommended apps available to download in the Samsung Gear app.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Info tab.
- 2. Tap View more apps to view options.

Download History

View your app download history from the Samsung Gear app.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Apps.
- 2. Tap More options > Download history to view your download history.

Uninstall Apps

You can also uninstall apps from the Gear.

- 1. On the Apps screen, touch and hold an app.
- Tap Uninstall. This option is not available for all apps.

You can also uninstall apps from the Gear using your smartphone.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Apps.
- 2. Tap More options > Uninstall, and then select apps to remove from the Gear.

Alarm

Set an alarm to ring at a specific time.

Create an Alarm

Create an alarm event. You can set one-time or recurring alarms.

- 2. Tap + Add and enter the time.
- 3. Tap Next, and select the days to repeat the alarm.
- 4. Tap Save when finished.

Stop an Alarm

- Drag X Cancel to the right or rotate the bezel clockwise to stop an alarm.
 - Drag ZZ **Snooze** to the left or rotate the bezel counterclockwise to snooze.

Delete an Alarm

You can delete an alarm that you created.

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap () Alarm.
- 2. Tap and hold an alarm, and then tap **Delete**.

Alti-Barometer

Measure the altitude and atmospheric pressure in your current location.

Measure Altitude

 From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Alti-barometer to view the altimeter and measure the altitude.

Measure Atmospheric Pressure

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Alti-barometer.
- 2. Rotate the bezel to the barometer screen to view the atmospheric pressure.

Customize Settings

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Alti-barometer, rotate the bezel to the Settings screen, and then tap Change.
- 2. Tap an option to customize:
 - Auto refresh: Automatically refresh the readings for altitude and pressure.
 - Manual calibration: Tap to enable manual calibration and enter the altitude and sea level pressure.
 - **Pressure alerts**: Enable pressure alerts when the atmospheric pressure drops more than 4 hPA within a 3 hour period.
 - Altitude unit: Customize the unit of measurement for altitude.
 - **Pressure unit**: Customize the unit of measurement for pressure.
 - Help: View help topics for the Alti-barometer.

Calendar

View the events scheduled on the smartphone.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap

 Calendar.
- 2. Rotate the bezel to view other months.
- 3. Tap a day on the monthly calendar.
 - The day's events list is displayed.
 - Tap an event to view its details
- 4. Rotate the bezel to view other scheduled events.

Create an Event

You can use your Calendar to create events.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap 21 Calendar.
- 2. Tap the day of the event, and tap + Create.
- 3. Enter the event details, and set a reminder.
- 4. Tap **Save** when finished.

Delete an Event

You can delete an event that you created.

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap 21 Calendar.
- 2. Tap the day of the event, and tap the event you want to remove to view it.
- 3. Tap More options > III Delete.

Contacts

View your smartphone's contact list.

Create a Contact

You can search for a contact or scroll through the list to find one by name.

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap **Output Output Output**
- 2. Tap (2) Add, and then enter the contact information.
- 3. Tap Save.

Find a Contact

You can search for a contact or scroll through the list to find one by name.

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap **Output Output Output**
- 2. Tap O Search, and then enter characters to find contacts that match.

– or –

Rotate the bezel to find the contact.

Call or Message a Contact

You can send a message or make a phone call from Contacts.

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap **Output Output Output**
- 2. Tap the contact you want to connect with, and tap an option:
 - Call: Begin a phone call with the contact.
 - (**D** Message: Type a message to the contact.

Email

View emails received on the smartphone and reply to them.

Read Emails

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Email.
- 2. Tap an email account to view its content.
- 3. Tap More options for additional options:
 - **Reply**: Compose a reply email from your Gear.
 - Star: Mark the email as important.
 - Show on phone: View the email on your smartphone.
 - **Delete**: Delete the email.

Note: You may not be able to reply to emails depending on the smartphone that you connect to the Gear.

Reply to Emails

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap Email.
- 2. Tap an email to open the email screen.
- 3. Scroll to the bottom of the email and tap *P* Reply.
- 4. Compose your email and send.

Delete Emails

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap Email.
- 2. Scroll through the inbox to the email you want to delete.
- 3. Tap More options > Delete.
- 4. Select the email again, and then tap **Delete**.

Find My Phone

If you misplace your smartphone, the Gear can help you find it.

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap **Find My Phone**.
- 2. Select an option:
 - Tap Start, and the smartphone emits sounds and turns on the screen.
 - Tap **1** Stop on the Gear to terminate the search.


Tap \times **Stop** on the smartphone.

Find Your Gear

You can also locate your Gear by making it light up and make sounds from the Samsung Gear app.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Find My Gear.
- 2. Tap 🔇 Start.
 - The Gear vibrates and the screen turns on.
- 3. Drag \times **Stop** to the right on the Gear.

Galaxy Apps

Samsung Galaxy Apps provides a quick and easy way to find and download free premium apps that are compatible with your Galaxy device.

A Samsung account is required to purchase and download apps.

To access the Samsung Galaxy Apps website:

From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Galaxy Apps

Gallery

View and manage images stored on the Gear.

View Images

- 2. Rotate the bezel to scroll through the image list and then tap an image to view it.

Zoom In or Out

While viewing an image:

Double-tap the image to zoom in or out.

Delete Images

- 2. Touch and hold an image to delete.

- Tap More options.
- 3. Tap **Delete**, and then tap Tap \checkmark **Ok** to confirm.

Import and Export Images

Images can be exchanged between your Gear and smartphone.

Import Images from Your Smartphone

Send images or entire albums from your smartphone to your Gear.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab.
- 2. Tap Transfer content to Gear.
- 3. Tap Select photos.

– or –

Tap Albums to sync.

4. Select files or albums and tap **Done**.

To sync images on your smartphone with your Gear:

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab.
- Tap Transfer content to Gear > Auto sync under Photos to enable.

Export Images to Your Smartphone

- 2. Tap the image you want to send to the smartphone.
- 3. Tap [●] More options > ├ Send to phone.

Messages

View messages and reply to or call the sender using the Gear.

Send Messages

- 2. Tap 🙆 Compose.
- 3. Add recipients and tap Next.
- 4. Enter text using one of the available methods.
 - If you use Quick responses or emojis, the message is automatically sent to the recipients when you tap it.
 - If you create a message using voice input or the keyboard, tap **Send** to send the message.

Edit Quick Messages

Edit or add templates used for replying to messages.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Quick messages.
- 2. Tap Quick responses.
 - To edit a message, select it and edit the text.
 - To create additional templates, tap 🕂 Add.
 - To delete or rearrange messages, tap **Edit**.

Send Audio Recordings

Change the message feature settings.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- 2. Tap App settings > Messages.
- 3. Tap **Send as audio** to set the Gear to send a voice message as an audio file.

Send SOS Requests

In an emergency situation, quickly press the Gear's **Home** button three times. The device sends messages to your emergency contacts. The first time you enable this feature, you will be prompted to designate your emergency contacts.

The messages include your location information. You can also send sound recordings along with the message to the recipients.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Send SOS requests.
- 2. Tap **On/Off** to enable this feature, and then customize options:
 - Send SOS messages to: Follow the prompts to add an emergency contact to send SOS messages to.
 - Count down before sending: Wait five seconds before sending SOS requests to allow them to be cancelled.

Read Messages

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap **Messages**.

 - **Repeat**: Tap to repeat all songs, tap again to repeat once, and tap again to turn off repeat.

 - On the library screen, you can view the currently playing song and playlist, and arrange music by tracks, albums, and artists.

Play Music On Your Smartphone

When you select a smartphone to play music from, you can control playback of the music with your Gear. The music plays on your smartphone.

- 2. Tap the output until the D Phone icon is displayed.

 - The music plays on your smartphone and the Gear displays the music controller screen.

Import Music

 - To edit a message, select it and edit the text.

Missed Calls

- Select your Gear from the Bluetooth list on the computer and tap ✓ OK on the Gear.
- 4. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the connection. The Gear and computer will be connected by Bluetooth.

Control PPT Slides with the Gear

You can remotely control the Powerpoint slides with your Gear.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap OPPT Controller.
- 2. Tap **Slideshow** to control the slides.
 - Tap (>) Next or rotate the bezel to the right to move to the next slide.
 - Tap () **Previous** or rotate the bezel to the left to move to the previous slide.

Only your most recent activity records are stored on your Gear. You can view previous data on the smartphone where the Samsung Health app is installed.

From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Samsung Health.

Although the Samsung Health application is a great companion to your exercise routine, it is always best to make sure you consult with your physician before beginning any exercise regimen. While moderate physical activity, such as brisk walking, is safe for most people, health experts suggest that you talk with your doctor before you start an exercise program, particularly if you have any of the following conditions: • Heart disease; Asthma or lung disease; Diabetes, or liver or kidney disease; and Arthritis.

Before beginning your exercise regimen check with your doctor if you have symptoms suggestive of heart, lung, or other serious disease, such as:

- Pain or discomfort in your chest, neck, jaw, or arms during physical activity;
- Dizziness or loss of consciousness;
- Shortness of breath with mild exertion or at rest, or when lying down or going to bed;

- A heart murmur or a rapid or pronounced heartbeat;

When your Gear and smartphone are connected, this feature uses your smartphone's location information.

Exercise with the Gear

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Samsung Health.
- 2. Rotate the bezel and tap **Exercise**.
- 3. Tap **Work out** and tap an activity type.
- 4. Enter the exercise information.
- 5. Tap **Start [activity type]** to start monitoring your exercise. Your heart rate measurement begins.
 - When you rotate the bezel to the right you can view exercise information, such as calories burned and current speed.
 - Rotate the bezel left to listen to music. This option is not available in Water lock mode.

Settings

Configure your device's connections and settings, sounds, display, security, and more.

How to Use Settings

Access Settings

You can personalize your device by configuring various setting options.

To access Settings:

From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.

On the Watch screen, swipe down from the top of the screen to open the status panel, and then tap Settings.

Connections

Manage connections between your device and a variety of networks and other devices.

Bluetooth

Use Bluetooth to connect the Gear to a smartphone and a headset (not included).

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap Settings.
- 2. Tap Connections > Bluetooth.
 - Bluetooth: Turn the Bluetooth feature on or off.
 - **BT headset**: Search for Bluetooth headsets and connect them to the Gear.

Note: The headset can only be used for playing music on the Gear.

Wi-Fi

Activate the Wi-Fi feature to connect to a Wi-Fi network.

- 2. Tap Connections > Wi-Fi.
- 3. Tap Wi-Fi again, and then tap Auto, Always on, or Always off.

Connect to a Wi-Fi Network

This feature is available when the Gear is not connected to the smartphone through Bluetooth.

- 2. Tap Connections > Wi-Fi.
- 3. Tap Wi-Fi networks > Scan.
- 4. Select a network from the Wi-Fi networks list.
 - Networks that require a password display a lock icon.
- 5. Tap Connect.

Note: Once the Gear connects to a Wi-Fi network, the Gear reconnects to that network each time it is available without requiring a password. To prevent the Gear connecting to the network automatically, select the network, and then tap **Forget**.

Sync Wi-Fi Profiles

Set the device to sync the list of saved Wi-Fi networks with your Gear.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap Samsung Gear > Settings tab.
- 2. Tap Gear connection > Sync Wi-Fi profiles.

NFC

The Gear lets you use the built-in technology to make payments and buy tickets for transportation or events after downloading and configuring the required apps.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- 2. Tap Connections > NFC.
 - NFC: Activate the NFC feature to link your Gear to your credit or debit card.
 - **Tap and pay**: Set the default payment app for mobile payments.

Make Payments with the NFC Feature

Before you can use the NFC feature to make payments, you must register for the mobile payment service. To register or get more information about the service, contact your service provider.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap

- 2. Tap Connections > NFC.
- 3. Tap **NFC** again to enable the feature.
- 4. Touch the top of the Gear's touchscreen to the card reader.

Note: The payment services list may not include all available payment apps.

Connection Alerts

Receive alerts when disconnected from Bluetooth.

- Tap Connections > Alerts to enable or disable this option.

Airplane Mode

Airplane mode disconnects your device from all networks and turns off connectivity features, such as phone calls and Wi-Fi.

- Tap Connections > Airplane mode to enable or disable this option.

Location

Some apps may require location services to be turned on for full functionality.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- 2. Tap Connections > Location.
- 3. Tap **Location** again to enable, and select a mode.
 - GPS & wireless networks: Use GPS and wireless networks.
 - Wireless networks: Use wireless networks only.
 - GPS: Use GPS only.

Connect to a New Phone

Connect your Gear to a new mobile device. The Gear can connect to another mobile device after performing a light reset to delete data.

To connect to a new phone:

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- 2. Tap Connect to new phone and follow the prompts.

Note: This feature is available when the Gear is connected to a smartphone. Otherwise, **Connect to phone** is displayed.

Sounds and Vibration

Configure the sounds and vibrations used to indicate notifications, screen touches, and other interactions.

Vibrations

Set your vibration preferences for the device.

Vibration Intensity

Configure the vibration intensity.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- Tap Vibration > Vibration intensity, and select Strong, Light, or None.

Long Vibration

Increase the duration of the vibration.

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap Settings.
- 2. Tap Vibration > Long vibration to enable.

Ringtone Vibration

Vibrate for calls.

- Tap Vibration > Ringtone vibration and select a vibration pattern.

Notification Vibration

Vibrate for new notifications.

- 2. Tap Vibration > Notification vibration and select a vibration pattern.

Notifications

Select which apps you want to receive alerts from. Alerts include notifications, sounds, and vibrations.

Do Not Disturb

Use these options to determine block out time where notifications are turned off, and during which time periods you want to enter this mode.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- Tap Device > Do not disturb, and configure the following:
 - Turn on now: Enable this option, and set the time period.
 - Turn on as scheduled: Tap Set schedule to configure the start time, end time, and days that you want to enable Do not disturb.

Display

Configure your display's brightness, screen timeout delay, and other display settings.

Watch Faces and Styles

Change the style settings.

- 2. Tap **Watch faces and styles**. The following options are available:
 - Watch faces: Select a watch type.
 - Watch always on: Set the Gear to display a watch when the screen is turned off.
 - Watch face order: Set a sort order.
 - Notification indicator: Enable or disable the notification indicator.
 - Status indicator: Indicators are icons that show the current status of your Gear on the watch face.

- Background style: Select a background.
- Font: Change the font style and size.

Adjust Screen Brightness

Manually adjust the brightness of the display.

- 2. Tap **Display** and select an option:
 - **Brightness**: Manually adjust the brightness of the display.
 - Auto low brightness: Set the Gear to automatically adjust the brightness depending on ambient light conditions.

Set the Screen Timeout

Set the length of time the Gear waits before turning off the display's backlight.

- 1. From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap Settings.
- Tap Display > Screen timeout, and select a timeout value.

Touch Sensitivity

Set the Gear to allow use of the touch screen with gloves on.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings.
- 2. Tap Device > Touch sensitivity.
- 3. Tap \checkmark **OK** to enable this feature.

Device Maintenance

Get an overview of the status of your device's battery, storage, memory, and device security. You can also automatically optimize your device's system resources.

Date and Time

You can set the date and time manually.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap Settings.
- 2. Tap General management > Date and time.
 - Set date: Set the date manually.
 - Set time: Set the time manually.
 - Select time zone: Select the time zone manually.

Note: The Date and time options are available when your Gear is not connected to your mobile device.

Power Saving Mode

Activate Power saving mode to save battery power by limiting the Gear's functions.

To save battery power, Power saving mode:

- Uses a grayscale Home screen
- Turns off notifications
- Turns off Wi-Fi
- Limits the maximum performance of the Gear.

To enable Power saving mode:

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings > Battery management.
- 2. Tap **Power saving**, and then tap \checkmark **OK**.

To disable Power saving mode:

► From the Home screen, tap Off, and then tap ✓ OK.

Watch Only Mode

Activate Watch only mode to save battery power by limiting the Gear's functions to only showing the time.

- From the Apps screen, rotate the bezel and tap
 Settings > Battery management.
- 2. Tap Watch only, and then tap \checkmark OK.

To disable Watch only mode:

► Touch and hold the **Power** button for three seconds.

Reset Gear

Reset settings to their factory default values and delete all data.

- 2. Tap General management > Reset Gear.
- 3. Tap **∕∕ OK**.

Gear Status

Access information about the Gear.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > About Gear.
- 2. Tap the icons at the top of the screen to view **Battery, Storage**, and **RAM** information.
- 3. Tap an option below for additional information:
 - Update Gear software: Update the Gear to the latest software.
 - Back up and restore: Back up the stored data on the Gear or restore backup data.

 - **PIN**: Set a PIN to use for unlocking the device when it removed from your wrist and the screen is turned off.
 - None: Do not lock the screen.
- 4. Tap **Help** to view help information for using the screen lock feature.

Security Update Service

You can update the security policy manually or automatically.

- 2. Tap Security > Security update service.
 - Check for updates: Update the Gear's security policy manually.
 - Auto update: Update the Gear's security policy automatically.
 - **Download updates**: Set the Gear to update the security policy automatically when connected to Wi-Fi. Options are Wi-Fi only and Wi-Fi and Mobile data.

Reactivation Lock

Set the Gear to require your Samsung account information after being reset. This prevents others from reactivating your device if it is lost or stolen.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Find My Gear.
- 2. Tap Reactivation lock and tap On/Off to enable.

Control remotely

Control your Gear remotely while both your smartphone and Gear are connected to a network, or Bluetooth.

You must be signed in to your Samsung account to enable this feature.

- From the Apps screen of the smartphone, tap
 Samsung Gear > Settings tab > Find My Gear.
- 2. Tap **Control remotely** and tap **On/Off** to enable.
- 3. Tap an option:
 - Locate Gear: Use your smartphone to scan for the Gear's location.
 - Lock Gear: Remotely lock the Gear to prevent unauthorized access.
 - **Reset Gear**: Your Samsung account password is required to remotely delete all personal information stored in the Gear. After the Gear is reset, you cannot restore the information or use the Find My Gear feature.
